Second doctoral colloquium

- 1. A joint meeting of all candidates and all members of mentoring commissions is organized at the end of the fifth semester (second doctoral colloquium), where the candidate submits a report and presents the results of his dissertation work.
- 2. A doctoral colloquium is used for students to get to know with the work of other colleagues, as well as to hear certain suggestions, but also to answer the questions asked, which is a way to prepare for the final public defense of the dissertation. On the basis of the presentation of the work and the discussion held, student can make appropriate corrections of the work.
- 3. Content / structure of the subject:

The content is part of the doctoral dissertation and the discussion that takes place

4. Methods of teaching:

Study research work with public announcement of results and debate about them.
