Monthly report about research progress

1. A PhD student reports about the progress of his dissertation. Reporting implies written material about the results that the student came to in the research work related to the doctoral dissertation. Students give their reports in the goal of continuous monitoring of doctoral dissertation work, as well as directing students and solving certain open questions or controversies that may happen during the preparation of the dissertation.

2. The report of the progress of the research as a result has the confirmation or contestation of the outcome, as well as possible suggestions that the student will receive based on the issues from the dissertation.

3. Reporting about the progress of the research involves reporting about all important elements of the dissertation: the hypotheses which they test (which current conclusions can be reached, whether it is necessary to change some of the starting hypotheses, which methods are applied in the research, whether the listed literature is really and relevant, or there should be certain changes.
