A detailed proposal of doctoral thesis

- 1. A PhD student after successfully passed exams on doctoral studies (acquired 87 ESPB) registers the proposal of doctoral thesis. The doctoral dissertation proposal must contain elements that will show scientific concept of the theme, as well as the proposed structure of the dissertation. In the registration student must clearly state the scientific hypotheses that will be tested in the work, the methodology of the scientific research work to be applied, the expected results to be achieved, and the literature that will be used.
- 2. By registering the proposal of doctoral dissertation, PhD student begins the procedure related to doctoral dissertation determination of the topic, structure, defence of the proposed topic, activities on the preparation of the doctoral dissertation, making doctoral dissertation, public defence of the doctoral dissertation.
- 3. The proposed topic of the doctoral dissertation may be a topic from the scientific field of the study program the student attends.

Proposal of doctoral dissertation must contain:

- 1. proposed subject and goal of the dissertation (show that this is an original idea, important for the development of science, its application,
- or the development of scientific thought in general),
- 2. The basic hypotheses from which the research starts (hypotheses that will be scientifically confirmed or overturned),
- 3. description of the contents (structure by chapters) of the dissertation,
- 4. methods that will be applied in the research,
- 5. expected results and scientific contributions,
- 6. a list of the literature to be used,
- 7. The topic of seminar work that the student defended, as well as a list of student's eventual scientific works.

During the preparation of the doctoral dissertation the scientific methods that will be used in the study-research work related to the dissertation, as well as in the dissertation itself, will be clearly stated.

4. Study-research work of the students with consultation with the mentoring committee and subject teachers.
